FREEDOM GUIDELINES

YOU CANNOT ATTEND FREEDOM IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN YOU BEING SENT HOME.

1. Everyone is expected to observe the highest standards of Christian conduct at all times.
2. You will be given a wristband that you will be required to wear for the weekend. This will help our church staff, hosts and leaders recognize that you are a part of the weekend.
3. The only way you can be excused from participating with your “family” for the weekend is a time away card. The link for time away cards is available at prestonwoodstudents.org.
4. You will be representing Christ, Prestonwood and your family. Please let your behavior and speech reflect this. We have a zero tolerance policy towards pranks, hazing, drugs, alcohol, pornography or any other behavior deemed un-Christlike.
5. Respect the church! No food or drinks allowed in the Worship Center. No standing or jumping on the pews. Students are not allowed in the terrace or balcony of the Worship Center.
6. Participate in EVERYTHING. Do your best to arrange your schedule so that you can take part in all activities. Do everything as a group.
7. If you drive your car to your host home (high school students only), the next time you drive will be to church on Sunday morning, unless you have an approved time away card. Car keys must be turned in to your Bible study leader when you arrive at your Host Home.
8. Strive to be a servant to your host family.
9. You are a guest in the home of your host family. Please honor their requests and treat their homes better than your own. Obey the host family’s “house rules”. If any damage is done, you will be responsible to pay for repairs.
10. You will be sent home if any violation occurs.
11. No cursing or use of profanity is allowed.
12. Be on time for all Bible studies, rallies, meals, etc.
13. Any and all computers and televisions are off limits to Bible Study leaders and students.
14. Come expecting to have a good time! Please be responsive to God’s Spirit and any commitment He would have you make!
