WHAT TO BRING

**Please mark your name clearly on ALL of your belongings

Bible/pen Sleeping bag/pillow Towel/personal toiletries Jeans, T-shirts, modest shorts Undergarments, socks, sleepwear Snacks for your Host Home Proper outerwear in case of cold weather \$10 for spending money (just in case!) <u>A friend!!</u>

DO NOT BRING

Balloons, questionable shirts or hats, alcohol, tobacco products, drugs, pornography, weapons, fireworks, computers/laptops, secular magazine or books, or bad attitudes! DO NOT BRING/WATCH QUESTIONABLE ENTERTAINMENT ON PERSONAL DEVICES. *Please inspect your student's luggage carefully before arriving to ensure safety.*

Students will be expected to use cell phones at the appropriate times, appropriate places, and in the appropriate way. Cell phones are not allowed in sleeping areas and must be turned in to a centrally located place before lights out. Inappropriate use of phones will result in communication with parents and determination of continued participation during the weekend.

FREEDOM GUIDELINES

YOU CANNOT ATTEND FREEDOM IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES. <u>FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN YOU BEING SENT HOME.</u>

- 1. Please let your behavior reflect what Freedom is about. We have a zero-tolerance policy towards pranks, hazing, drugs, alcohol, pornography or any other behavior deemed inappropriate.
- 2. No cursing or use of profanity is allowed. Only positive attitudes.
- 3. You will be given a wristband that you will be required to wear for the whole weekend.
- 4. The *only* way you can be excused from participating with your Host Home for the weekend is with a Time Away card. Access these at <u>www.prestonwoodstudents.org/timeaway</u>.
- 5. Respect the church! No food or drinks allowed in the Worship Center. No standing or jumping on the pews/chairs. Students are not allowed in the terrace or balcony of the Worship Center.
- 6. Respect your leader! What they say goes.
- 7. Respect your host home assignment. A lot of prayer and time has been spent on this. Trust the Lord and what He wants from you for Freedom Weekend.
- 8. Participate in EVERYTHING. Do your best to arrange your schedule so that you can take part in all activities. Do everything as a group.
- 9. If you drive your car to your Host Home (HS students only), the next time you drive will be to church on Sunday morning, unless you have an approved Time Away card. Car keys must be turned in to your leader when you arrive at your Host Home.
- 10. Strive to be a servant to your host family.
- 11. You are a guest in the home of your host family. Please honor their requests and treat their homes better than your own. Obey the host family's "house rules." If any damage is done at any point throughout the weekend, you will be responsible to pay for repairs.
- 12. Be on time for all small group sessions, worship sessions, meals, etc.
- 13. Come expecting to have a good time! Please be responsive to God's Spirit and any commitment He would have you make!
