

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

## Scripture

John 6:52-69

## Session Summary

Once we get through the top layers of offense in Christ's hard teaching, we get to the most offensive truth of all. Jesus' teaching strikes at the heart of every one of us, whether we are Jew or Gentile, religious or irreligious. While everything in the world and everything within us calls us to believe that "we have what it takes," Christ levels the ground at the foot of the cross. We have nothing but need. If you want salvation, you must have all of Jesus. And you must be "all in." You don't have what it takes. But He does.

## Conversation Questions

- Why do people often think that salvation is something we can earn?
- How would you explain to someone that the only way to be saved is through Jesus?
- Based on verse 63, what is the role of the Spirit in our salvation?
- Why is following Jesus worth it?
