

CONNECT TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES (LifeGroup and MDWK)

Creating a culture in which students feel comfortable, welcome, and seen. Connect Team members will specifically connect with guests, first-timers, and anyone in need of follow-up. In addition to this, Connect Team members also act as a social coordinator for their LifeGroup, assisting their LifeGroup leader in creating community.

Greeting

- Engaging in conversation with all students and leaders
- Using high fives, fist bumps, and smiles
- Holding doors open at all major entrances
- Connecting new students to LifeGroup Leaders & other students
- Looking for those with guest wristbands and engaging with them

Guest Central and Check-In

- Setting up check-in systems
 - Tablets, printers, wristbands, and name tags
- Setting up First-Time Guest Booth
- Taking guests to their LifeGroup and connecting them with their Leader
- Sitting with guests at MDWK
- Ensuring guests fill out the First-Time Guest Form
- Welcoming and assisting as students and leaders check in

Group Engagement/Follow Up

- Following up with First-Time guests at your LifeGroup
- Following up with MIAs (those who have missed LifeGroup three consecutive weeks in a row)
- Assisting LifeGroup Leaders to plan group-specific social events outside of Sunday mornings
- Occasionally provide icebreakers for the group
- Aiding in LifeGroup discussion by including others in the conversation
- Communicating Prestonwood Student announcements

CREATIVE TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES (LifeGroup and MDWK)

The Creative team is responsible for clearly and effectively communicating the message and hope of the Gospel through worship, technology, and digital media. The goal within the creative team is to strive for excellence in executing each task and opportunity that is assigned to advance the Gospel. This team will serve during ministry programs for our HS and JHigh gatherings and events (LifeGroups, MDWK, Nights of Worship, and **Freedom**).

- Learn and study assigned music

- Well-rounded in Planning Center Online (PCO)

Technology

- Trained in assigned role
 - Lighting
 - ProPresenter (PVP)
 - Audio
- Participate in rehearsals during scheduled rotation
- Assist in technology booth setup and testing
- Help with moving on-stage elements (Teaching table/Sermon illustrations)

Digital Media

- Take and edit photographs
- Collect catalog of images, posts and more to share
- Create promotions and graphics
- Assist in content creation for Student Ministry Socials
- Shoot and edit videos for LifeGroup and MDWK creative elements
- Interact relevantly with students via social media

SERVICE TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES (LifeGroup and MDWK)

Creating a culture of service in Prestonwood Students, Service Team members will create an environment for others to hear and see the Gospel both inside and outside the church walls. Taking initiative for opportunities presented, Service Team members will not only be the ones serving, but also encouraging those around them to join in the mission.

Set-Up and Tear Down

- Placing program-specific materials, such as table toppers, directional signage, pens, and other items as needed
- Ensuring all tables/chairs are set and well-spaced
- Organize snacks, food orders, or giveaways on special occasions
- Making sure the venue is cleaned and ready for the next event

Mobilization

- Championing other ministries of the church through serving/volunteering (examples: Adventure Week, Parents Night Out, Greeting with signs at Easter)
- Encouraging LifeGroup/other students to join us with service initiatives
- Boldly sharing about upcoming service opportunities
- Repeatedly sharing the “why” behind serving others
- Encouraging and sharing registration of Prestonwood Students events such as Freedom, Mission Trips, and Beach Camp

TEACHING TEAM (11th and 12th grade only)

The Teaching Team member exists to develop students in their ability to teach the truths of God's Word with their peers. We know that students who become disciples make disciples.

Opportunities

- Members will have the chance to teach a 10-12 minute lesson from stage to all Prestonwood Students to lead into LifeGroups for discussion time.
- Leading and assisting the discussion time of LifeGroup
- Clearly explaining and teaching passages of Scripture
- Challenge other students with life applications from the lesson
- Present from stage during High School MDWK in areas such as Scripture Reading, Welcome/Greeting, Vision Casting, and/or Devotionals.

Expectations

- The Teaching Team is a secondary team, meaning students must also be serving on one of our three primary teams alongside the Teaching Team. We believe that teaching God's Word is a high calling and an important responsibility in which having a servant's heart is a pre-requisite
- Take time daily to prepare and pray through the devotionals and curriculum
- Attend all trainings and meetings.
